Press Report

The Tower May Medal coincided with the Coronation but still had a healthy entry. Dean Kinley was crowned winner of Division 1 with a fine round of 73-7=66. He started with a birdie on the first which is usually regarded as a bad omen and followed it with a bogey on the second. Another birdie on the ninth helped him to an outward nine of 36 gross. He had a steady back nine and finished with a birdie on the last to give him a two-shot advantage over second placed Mike Rae (69-1=68). Rae birdied the third and the fifth but dropped a shot on the sixth giving him an outward nine of 34 gross. A shot dropped on the tenth and eleventh proved costly although birdies on fourteen and eighteen were enough to see off the challenge of one of the elder statesmen, Bill Denard. Denard had a 77-9=68 but lost out on a back nine countback.

In Division 2 there was a battle royal between Rickie Bridson (83-18=65) and Orry Teare (84-18=66). Bridson went out in 44 but came roaring down the back straight with a 39. Teare could not quite match it and a bogey on the last hole proved decisive. Just missing out was Tom Chalmer with (86-19=67). The best gross of the day was won by Mike Rae with his 69.

There were 15 "No Returns". The Handicap Committee would like to remind competitors that if they do "N.R" they should still record the scores on the remaining holes and enter them in the system. They must also hand in their cards after completing their round. It is also a requirement of the club that competitors put the Handicap Index on the card – see 'Competition Entry Process' on the Notice Boards and at the Start Sheet Station.

On Tuesday the seniors competed for the Gregor Murray Memorial Trophy. This popular event in memory of a popular member was keenly contested by 30 of the Senior Gents. When I say "keenly contested" this is not a reflection of the scoring. The winner was Mr Captain, Richard Miller, with 33 points. Six players had 32 points and had to be separated by a countback. Gordie Clark was second with Dave Evans in third. We were delighted to welcome Daphne Murray, Gregor's widow, to present the trophy and prizes.

This weekend we have President's Day on Saturday followed by the re-arranged Tower Stableford Round 3 on Sunday.
