He then steadied the ship with several pars. Bogeys on 6 & 7 were understandable in the conditions, and he finished the outward nine with a birdie on the ninth. Birdies on the shortened par 5 tenth and the seventeenth led to a commendable total of 38 points. Rolling back the years even more was Phil Scott. A triple bogey on the first and blobs on the third and fourth holes was not the most auspicious of starts but

Captain Scott (unlike his namesake) got back on course and went out in 15 points. The return journey yielded 21 points giving a total of 36. Maurice Hughes had an eventful round with triple bogeys on 9 & 14 and a double on 18 which meant he finished third on the countback just edging out Jacob Crook – both players having 36 points. In the Ladies' Competition Shirley Kennaugh racked up 36 points to see off the challenge of Donna Primrose-Smith. Primrose-Smith amassed 13 points on the outward nine but stormed back with 21 points on the return. Nearest the pins were: 8th Orry Teare, 13th Juan Corrin, 16th Jacob Crook. Round 3 of the Tower Insurance Stableford Series was played on "Mad Sunday". Jonny Weir must have been pretty mad when he started his lap with a double bogey on the first for 0 points. A birdie 3 on the third got his round back on the road and a further 8 pars and a birdie on 17 meant his 39 points was enough to win, beating Kevin Roberts, who also had 39, on a countback.

The Seniors played for the White Rose Trophy in memory of Steve Waterhouse and kindly sponsored by his widow, Irene. A proud Yorkshireman he always gave a Pie and a Pint (of Yorkshire beer-the best!) for the nearest the pins. These are nearly as hotly contested as the main prize!
